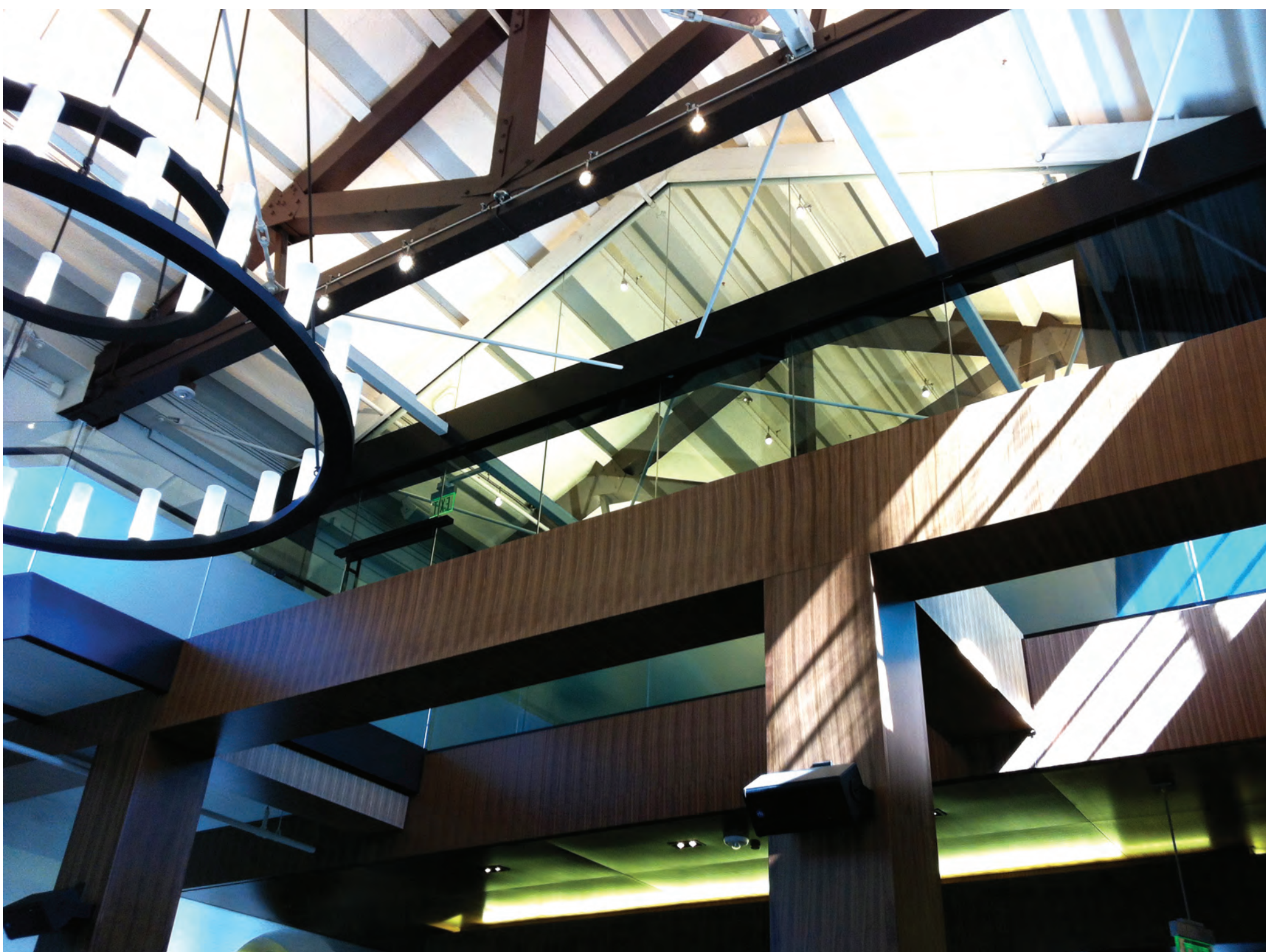


University Club Relocation & Expansion
